#### **LANDSCAPE ENHANCEMENT**

There seems to be some confusion and concern about the landscaping about to start in Brandywine. At this point in time there are five phases.

Phase I

Start planting 144 trees in the front yard.

Phase 2

Remove the rest of the carrotwoods.

Phase 3.

Replace carrotwoods and start doing the back of units.

Phase 4

Work on front entry of complex and pool and tennis courts area.

Phase 5

Bushes in area.

As you can see this is going to be very time consuming. This is NOT going to happen overnight. We are looking at a few years for the final project. Many people are concerned

that the company is going to come in here and start ripping out bushes and flowers that are planted around our homes. This is not the case. The landscaper has said if the bushes look good there is no reason to replace. I hope this helps to know what is being planned. Karen Miller
