<u>Driver License or ID card facts</u>: Florida does not reciprocate REAL ID requirements from

out of state. Things not acceptable are birth or marriage certificates. Disabled Vets must have a letter from Veteran's Administration stating 100% disability for a discount. Basic vision acuity testing is required for each original or renewal driver license issuance. FYI, credentials on your driver's license will have a star in the upper right-hand corner. If there isn't a star, it will be necessary to go to the license bureau to obtain the proper one. Just bear in mind that the beginning and end of the month is a busy time and I would suggest heading in that direction mid-month.
