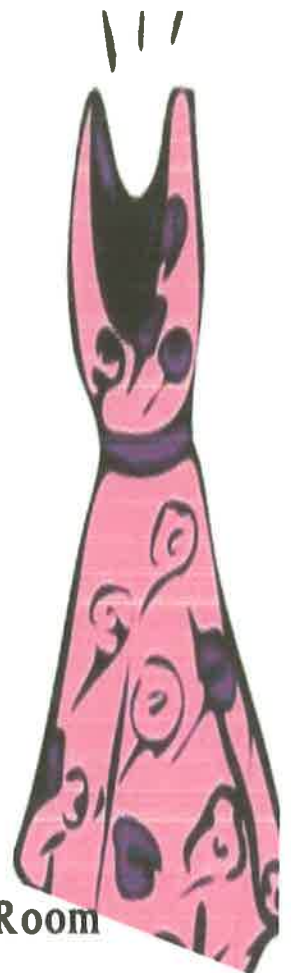

2019-2020 schedule via Tour4You

- Kennedy Space Center** – Two days in August 2019, Day 1 - arrive early at the Visitor Complex Seeing U.S. Space Mission Zones, Center Bus Tour, IMAX Theater, Atlantis Shuttle, selection of dining venues on your own, hotel overnight, Day 2- after breakfast, visit Winter Garden, enjoy small- town charm, the lobby of the Edgewater Hotel est. 1927, old-fashioned shops and restaurants, leaving to return late afternoon or early evening. \$169 pp tour & hotel
- Savannah** – Three days early Nov. or Dec 2019, Day 1 -arrives in River District to tour area sites on your own, hotel two nights, Day 2 – after paid breakfast, bus to Visitors Center for trolley tour of the city, afternoon & evening on your own, Day 3 – after paid breakfast, bus to St. Simon’s Island to sightsee the area and have lunch (on own), leave for return with short rest break. \$219 pp tour & hotel
- New Orleans** – Four days in Jan. or Feb. 2020 (not during Mardi Gras), Day 1 – traveling with comfort stops and lunch (on own), photo op at Battleship Park in Mobile Bay, arrive at hotel before or after dinner on own, Day 2 – after paid continental breakfast, bus to New Orleans for guided tour of city ending at the French Quarter, browse and lunch on your own, meet bus for return to hotel in afternoon, Day 3 – after paid continental breakfast, enjoy a brief ferry ride across the Algiers, spend the day exploring as you wish, Bus will have 2 pick-up times for return to hotel to allow dinner on your own in New Orleans (you will receive lists of sites and restaurants). Day 4 – After paid continental breakfast, travel home with comfort and lunch (on your own) stops enroute. \$319 pp tour & hotel
- Tarpon Springs** - One day in Mar. 2020 includes Nature Cruise on the Anclote River, Sponge Docks time on your own for meals, times for departure & return will be set depending upon traffic \$69 pp

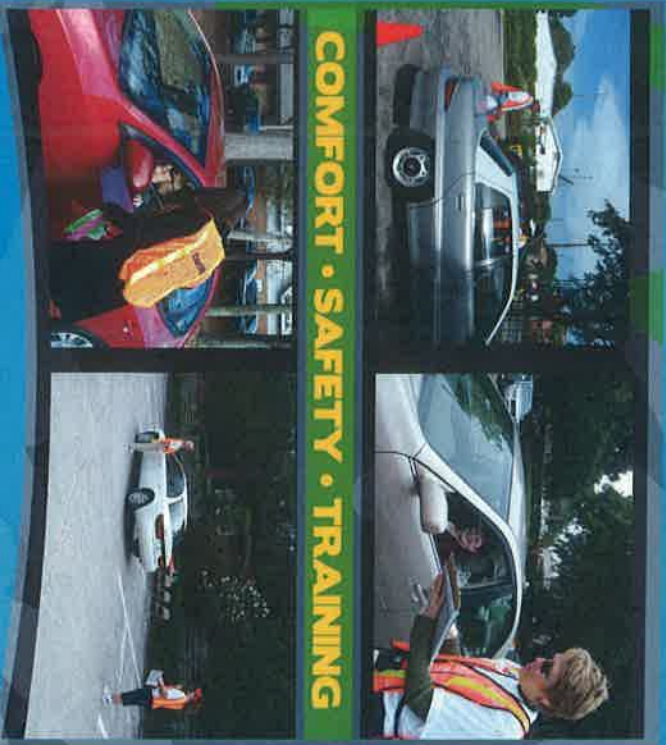

What Is CarFit?

CarFit is a national education program. Our goal is to help mature drivers stay safe on the road. It is a parking lot activity where trained volunteers use a checklist of items to review comfort and safety in your vehicle. Our team may make recommendations for you to consider, but no changes will be made to your car. CarFit is a safety check up for your car...

Why Should I Come?

As we age, physical changes in vision, flexibility, strength, etc., may make us less comfortable in a car and may reduce our control of the vehicle. Simple solutions like learning about safety features of your car or adaptive devices may help you continue to stay safe on the road.



What Do They Do?

Our volunteers will:

- Ask questions about proper safety belt use and fit
- Measure how far you are away from a steering wheel with an airbag
- Look at your line of sight above the steering wheel
- Review the position of mirrors to minimize blind spots
- Have you test vehicle controls such as head lights, emergency flashers, etc. to make certain that the car is doing its job in keeping you safe

How Long Does This Take?

You and your vehicle will spend about 20-30 minutes with us.

What Does It Cost?

There is no charge. This is a community service brought to you by our national and local sponsoring organizations and our volunteers.

What Do I Get?

We will provide information about resources in your area, a copy of the checklist and any recommendations suggested for you.
