

Reminders from Management:

PREPARING YOUR HOME FOR EXTENDED LEAVES



Are you prepared to leave for the summer or just leave for a nice vacation? Please consider the following suggestions:

- Alert the main office of the dates you are away and ensure your key on file is up to date
- Update all phone numbers and addresses with main office
- Make sure to have a home watch service to ensure your home remains protected during the times you are away. Please alert the association of who you have designated for access to your home in case of an emergency.
- Make sure to turn off your main water
- Leave your AC **ON**; Summer in Florida is hot and humid, non-controlled temperatures in the home can result in damages, such as mold.
- Store your vehicles in your garage.
- Remove any personal items from your front entry and surrounding exterior areas when you are away for long time periods. This ensures personal property is not damaged and no extra debris can become a projectile during strong winds. *Including hanging pots, decorative items on the building, wind chimes, lanterns, furniture, potted plants regardless of size, statues, flags, solar lighting, etc.*
