FROM THE NEST

Common Sense on cost for cooling your unit in the heat of the summer begins with the thermostat. Setting it around 78, a bit lower or higher, can save 5 percent of your monthly cooling costs. Always set the fan on auto so it is consistent. Even installing a smart thermostat can add up to 3% savings on your total energy cost. Use ceiling fans when in a room to feel cooler, but there's a word of caution. Keeping them on constantly can cost up to \$7 a month. Check the AC filter regularly and, importantly, remove debris from the unit and make sure plantings are at least 18 inches away. Keep sunlight out with shades and blinds and consider attic insulation, both in your living area, along with the garage. Insulation installed on the garage door is also a plus with keeping heat from penetrating the inside. Remember, a dollar saved is a dollar earned, no matter how trivial it seems. Consistency is the name of the game!
