SAFETY REMINDER

With many out riding and walking right now here are a few reminders on bike and walking safety.

Here's to a Safe Bicycle Ride

Brandywine is fortunate to have members riding bicycles and walking throughout the community. May is National Bicycle Month and a good time to renew some basic rules.

Bicyclists Should Follow Rules

Bicyclists need to know and follow rules that actually are intended to keep them safe. Some of these include:

- Ride only on the right side of the road going the same direction as motor vehicle traffic.
- Stop at all stop signs.
- Never use earbuds or headphones when riding bicycles.
- Don't talk on cellphones when riding bicycles.
- Bicyclists should use a headlight and taillight when riding at night, dusk to dawn, rain or fog to let motorists know that you are there; remember that they can't see you if you're in dark clothing and have no lighting on either the bicycle or clothing.

Note: Pedestrians should walk facing motor traffic so that they can tell when a vehicle is approaching.

Brain Injury or Bad Hairdo?

Would you rather have a messed-up hairdo or brain damage? Many bicyclists think that

just because they're biking in their own community it's not necessary to wear a helmet. But accidents happen there just as often as if you were on a long ride. It's important not only that you wear a helmet but also that the helmet is fitted and worn properly; an improperly worn (or old) helmet is as bad as not wearing one at all. Here are the five steps in the proper procedure for fitting and wearing a bicycle helmet:

- The helmet should be level on the head.
- You should be able to fit one or two fingers between the bottom of the helmet and above the eyebrow.
- The front and back straps should be equally tight and meet a "V" just below the ears.
- You should be able to fit one or two fingers between the chin and the chin strap.
- A proper-fitting helmet will not move on your head.

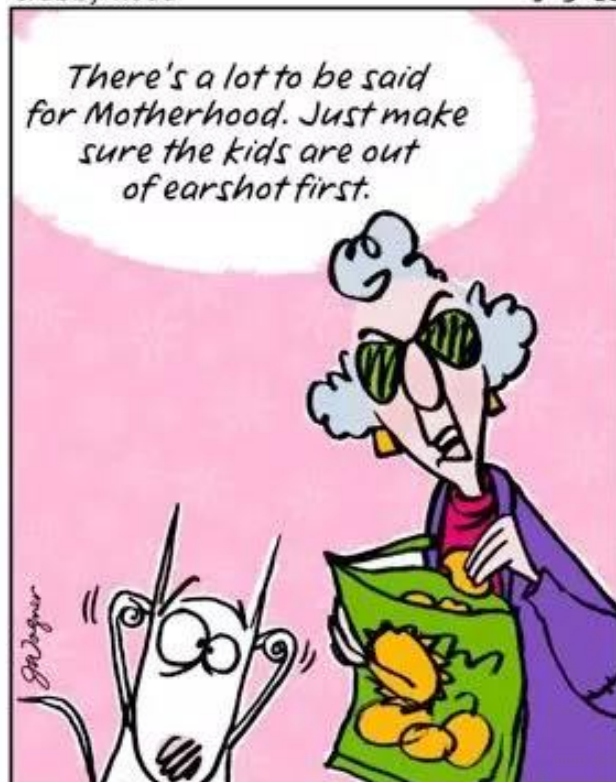
