ATTENTION ALL RESIDENTS FEBRUARY ASSOCIATION DUES

The 2023 budget (included in the annual meeting packet and available on the website) was approved by the Board on January 5, 2023 at which time, by a polling of those in attendance, it was decided to pay the difference ("catch-up") between the amount of the January payment made (2022 monthly amount) and the now approved 2023 monthly amount (noted in the budget) by February 1st- but no later than February 5th to avoid late fees. For those submitting checks from their bank, this "catch-up" should be submitted along with your February payment, as no coupons will be sent for the "catch-up" (cost savings). For those who have signed up for direct debit payment with Precedent, your bank account will be debited for your "catch-up" payment (with no late fees incurred) as soon as possible after they debit your normal 2023 payment on February 1st. The difference between the 2 payments (the "catch-up") amount is: Brandywine units \$198.91; Hazeltine units \$134.26: all other units \$173.83. March payment amounts will resume as normal according to the budget. If you have any questions on amounts or how to pay the "catch-up" you owe, please contact the Brandywine Office. I encourage all residents to move to direct debit payments with Precedent to save the cost associated with resident submitted payments(coupon printing/ mailing and lockbox/ e-check fees.) Every dollar to cut operational costs. Please call the Brandywine office if you need assistance in setting up the direct debit payments. Thank you for your understanding and help as we work though the logistics of Board transition and cost saving measures.
