Dear Fellow Owners,

The town hall meeting held by RealManage on Tuesday, August 19 was intended to present an introduction to the Ciranet system with an opportunity to meet the new office staff. Despite a trial run on Monday, trying to use Zoom and accessing Ciranet incurred some technical hiccups at Tuesday's meeting.

The Board is working with RealManage to schedule training sessions for owners to learn how to access their accounts on Ciranet and get one-on-one help. There will be in-person sessions as well as virtual sessions to avoid technical issues. RealManage staff cannot replace Precedent staff until after August 31 and Precedent staff cannot assist with changing assessment payments to RealManage.

In the meantime, please rest assured that we are all aware that changing management companies presents challenges. Late fees will not be applied to assessment payments due in September 2025 so long as the payment is made no later than September 30, 2025. We hope this reassures you of the Board's support during this change as well as provides you some flexibility during the transition.

Additionally, if you know an owner who does not have email access, please convey this message to them.
